COVID-19 Visitation Plan

Effective 7th December 2020

Thank you to all relatives, friends and contractors who have abided by our visitation plans over the past 8 months to keep residents and staff safe during the Covid 19 pandemic.

The Australian government has released new guidelines for visitation to Residential Aged Care Facilities in late November to assist facilities to implement safe visitation based on community transmission and escalation tiers if Covid cases are present in our community.
