



Visitation Regulations Explained:

Visitors within and outside our Local Health District.



Northern NSW Local Health District (NNSWLHD) covers the area in north eastern NSW extending from Tweed Heads in the north to Tabulam and Urbenville in the west and to Nymboida and Grafton in the south, an area of 20,732 square kilometres.

Mareeba management meet fortnightly via teleconference with our LHD. Through this regular forum and email updates if new cases present , Mareeba are able to closely monitor the Covid-19 cases and community transmission in our area.

For this reason allowing visitors from only our LHD is a safe first step.

Exceptions will be made for relatives who are outside our LHD based on each individual request to DON or DDON.

If an *out of district* visit is approved, it must be for no longer than 30 minutes and a mask will be supplied by the facility to be worn for the entire visit.

We thank you for your co-operation in this ongoing situation. We will continue to work together with residents and their visitors to find the right balance between protecting residents from COVID-19 and providing vital social connections and support. Our priority is keeping our Residents and Staff safe.
